

Consequences Quiz game – created by Hannah Barnes

Items needed

- Flip chart with quiz children's details on
- Pens
- Bell
- Prizes

Start

Put the parents in 2 teams.

Ask the parents to come up with a team name

Rules

Group leader to read out a quiz child's detail. Then one of the problem behaviours. The teams must come up with a suitable consequence. Teams must ring bell before answering. If answer is unsuitable then question is presented to the other team

Points

1 point for right answer

Extra points for back up consequence and for additional strategies they may put in
