Zoom session group agreement

- Your child/ren's needs come first so please attend to them as necessary during the session. However, make sure you leave the zoom group and the room with them.
- Try and find a quiet space and commit time to the session (as far as possible).
- Due to safeguarding it is important that your children are not seen on video. It is also important they don't hear the content of the zoom conversation; we can't predict what is going to be discussed.
- Turn off the mic unless you are speaking to eliminate background noise.
- Be appropriately dressed for calls – as though you are coming to group!
- Only use appropriate language and be considerate of others
- If other adults within the household are going to join in, please inform facilitator prior to start to seek agreement of other members.
- Make use of the chat option to share ideas and thoughts.
- You have the option to turn off camera or leave if necessary (due to home circumstance or difficult topic/conversation). Please let the facilitator know through private chat message if you do this; we need to know you are safe and well. This will be followed by a phone call after the session.
- If you need to get facilitators attention privately please use the private chat and they will respond, as necessary.
- Do not record the session.
- Be aware that what you share in the group is confidential within in professional limits. If the facilitators have any concerns about what is shared, they will follow these up and report, as necessary. And try to discuss with group member first.
- Just like in our groups; make yourself a cup of tea or coffee to enjoy during the group session 😊.
